

UCA ALL AMERICAN INFORMATION

Each cheer squad attending UCA camp can nominate squad members to compete for the honor of being named **“UCA All American”**. All seniors are eligible to tryout. If there are no seniors, then a maximum of six squad members may be nominated to tryout. Junior High and Junior Varsity teams may nominate up to six team members to try out.

Selection Process

Each candidate will perform the Xtreme dance routine, a camp cheer and a jump. All American tryouts are usually held the third day of camp. The head instructor will let you know the exact time and location of the All American tryout. Candidates will tryout in groups of three or more.

Sophomore, Junior and Senior All Americans will have the opportunity to perform in the London Parade, New Year's Day before one million spectators lining the parade route. The travel dates are December 26, 2013 – January 2, 2014. The UCA staff chaperones the All Americans to ensure their safety and fun! Sophomore, Junior and Senior All Americans are also eligible to attend the Thanksgiving Events as well, based on the state in which they attend camp.
